

Arctic alive! lessons are listed below. In conjunction with each lesson, there is a description of the assessment method(s) associated with that particular lesson. Each lesson has an assessment listed, however, they are not all intended to be graded. Some assessments are simply check-points along the way to see if there is information or skill that need to be addressed.

It is up to the individual teacher to decide which lessons and methods will be used for grading purposes. There are four possible components of the total assessment:

- 1) Student Science Journal (can grade some or all of the worksheets) This section includes the pre-assessment
- 2) Policy Debate Activity
- 3) Written post-assessment
- 4) Final Assessment Activity (Optional)
