

Expedition Day 3 Questions and Answers

- 1) Have you seen any major changes in the occurrence of wildlife in the last decade? Yes, increases in both caribou and whales.
- 2) How do the Inuit get seals out of their seal holes? There are numerous way to get seals: out in open water, nets, and dens.
- 3) I've heard that the Inuit have something like 27 different names for ice. Can you explain that? We have many more than 27. You would use many adjectives with the word ice to describe it, for instance rotting ice. Where as we have one word to describe that.
- 4) How do the Inuit hunt whales from pack ice? We go out to the edge of the shore fast ice.
- 5) How do you study whales? By listening for them or tracking them with sonar. We also take tissue samples.
- 6) How far out on the pack ice have you been? A couple of hundred miles by air and 60 miles from land.
